The following winning routines will receive an invitation to compete in the Final Challenge.

Solos:

- **Mini** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.
- **Children** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.
- **Junior** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.
- **Teen** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.
- **Senior** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.
- **Adult** - Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) solo performances across different genres.

Duet/ Trio/ Quartets:

- **Mini/Children/Junior** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances across different genres.
- **Teen** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances across different genres.
- **Senior/Adult** - Top 2 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances in the Senior section and Highest Scoring (1st Place) performance from Adult Section across different genres.



Groups:

- **Mini/Children/Junior** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances across different genres.
- **Teen** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances across different genres.
- **Senior** – Top 3 highest-scoring (1st Place) performances across different genres.

Overall winners in each above-mentioned categories will receive cash prizes.
